



- ✓ Uma base de conhecimento e informação sólida.






Projectos financiados por fundos comunitarios em OEM na Europa

Conference Conclusions: adoption of a joint roadmap

Joint Roadmap to accelerate Maritime/Marine Spatial Planning processes worldwide (MSP)

Priority areas and key actions

Priority area: Transboundary maritime/marine spatial planning

- o Guidance
- Projects
- . A pilot project in 2018 to test practices of cross-border cooperation with non EU Member States.
- . IOC-UNESCO will act as the technical support agency for Large Marine Ecosystem (LME) partnerships
- . IOC will implement pilot activities in 2 or 3 LME projects in Africa, South America/Caribbean region, and South East Asia.

Priority area: Blue economy

- Studies
 - . In 2017, DG MARE will launch two studies on MSP and Blue Growth:
 - The first study will focus on how MSP processes and plans may underpin Blue Growth.
 - The second study will focus on the economic benefits of having MSP processes.
- . IOC-UNESCO will build on the results of these studies to review their common principles MSP processes for Blue Growth end-users.
- Conferences
 - . In October 2017, first conference on MSP for Blue Growth to share best practices.

Priority area: Ecosystem-based maritime/marine spatial planning

. Sharing of MSP-relevant information. National authorities face the double challenge of measuring cumulative effects on ecosystems and assessing the needs of interconnected ecosystems

Environmental pressures

. Transboundary Water Assessment Programme

Priority area: Capacity building

. However the degree of implementation of MSP is not uniform, nor is the level of institutional, technical and human capacities at national level.

Training for planners

- . To identify specific training needs, a global survey will be implemented as a first step of this activity with a view to tailor MSP training to regional needs.
- Pilot projects
 - . DG MARE will launch a pilot project in 2018 in the Pacific region.
- . IOC-UNESCO will propose that a "Twinning programme" between European institutions and those from other parts of the world.

Priority area: Building Mutual understanding and communicating MSP

- International forum
 - . The first workshop will be held the course of 2018.
- Developing communication strategies for MSP
